Ambulance Cleaning Processes [A2 / A1]

Sizes: A2 (594x420) & A1 (840x594)

Materials: Dibond or Rigid Plastic

Cleaning Ambulance Interior

Infection Prevention Control

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Floor Cleaning

- Preparation [Bucket Application]**
Dispense premixed Uni9 Hard Surface & Floor Cleaner Solution via dispenser to required level. If dispensing manually, add 2 doses of Uni9 Hard Surface & Floor Cleaner concentrate per 4 litres of water into a YELLOW bucket.
- Pre-Clean Floor**
Sweep floor area with a soft brush or vacuum to pre-clean and remove all visible soiling. If required, agitate surface to help remove stubborn soil.
- Clean Floor**
Apply Uni9 Hard Surface & Floor Cleaner Solution to floor area and allow contact time.
- Rinse**
Rinse with clean water and remove as much excess water on surface as possible. Use a floor squeegee if required.

Surface Cleaning

- Preparation [Spray Application]**
Dispense premixed Uni9 Hard Surface & Floor Cleaner Solution via dispenser to the required level. If dispensing manually add 1 dose of Uni9 Hard Surface & Floor Cleaner concentrate with 500ml of water into a trigger bottle.
- Pre-Clean Surface**
Spray all the surfaces with Uni9 Hard Surface & Floor Cleaner Solution, wipe surface clean and remove all visible soiling. If required agitate surface to help remove stubborn soil.
- Sanitise Surface**
Apply either the Medi9 RTU Spray or Medi9 Wipes to all surfaces; trolley, stretcher, chairs, and all equipment including medical devices. Allow to air dry.

Infectious Disease Deep Clean

[Advice/Recommended: Use of FFP3 face mask in addition to recommended PPE when carrying out high level disinfection processes.]

- Preparation**
Clean interior as per floor and surface recommendations.
- Sanitise Area**
High level disinfect with Medi9 RTU Spray and wipe all surfaces, medical devices, and equipment paying special attention to all touch points.
- Cleaning Process**
Fog interior of vehicle using the Medi9 Air Sanitisation Machine. Ensure a fine mist covers all areas, not necessary to soak surfaces. Allow vehicle to vent and air dry for 30 mins before re-occupation (typical fogging process should take no longer than 3 mins).
- Safety Check Air Sanitisation Machine**
Store Air Sanitisation machine horizontally. If in regular use, the remaining chemical can be left in the tank for 3-4 days. Wipe down Air Sanitisation Machine and flush machine with Medi9 Air Sanitisation Solution every 4 weeks.

Cleaning Ambulance Exterior

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Manual Cleaning

- Personal Protection**
Ensure you are wearing the appropriate protective equipment for prolonged use of chemicals.
- Preparation**
Dispense premixed Uni9 Traffic Film Remover (TRF) solution via dispenser to the required level. If dispensing manually add 4 doses of Uni9 TRF concentrate per 4 litres of water into a bucket.
- Pre-Clean**
Pre-clean surface and rinse off any large build-up of mud and dirt from the vehicle exterior.
- Clean**
Apply Uni9 TRF to vehicle exterior from the bottom of the vehicle working up and allow contact time. Do not allow solution to dry.
- Scrub**
Using a wash brush, agitate surface to help remove stubborn soil.
- Rinse**
Rinse vehicle exterior with clean water from the top, working down and allow to air dry.

Pressure Wash Cleaning

- Personal Protection**
Ensure you are wearing the appropriate protective equipment for prolonged use of chemicals.
- Preparation**
Insert chemical dip tube from pressure washer into bottle of Uni9 TRF. Pressure washer will automatically dose chemical. Alternatively fill chemical tank.
- Pre-Clean**
Pre-rinse vehicle removing remaining large build up of mud and dirt from exterior of vehicle.
- Clean**
Activate chemical additive on pressure washer. Apply Uni9 TRF to vehicle exterior from the bottom of the vehicle working up and allow contact time. Do not allow solution to dry.
- Scrub**
If necessary scrub with wash brush to remove any stubborn soiling.
- Rinse**
Disable chemical additive on pressure washer, rinse vehicle exterior with clean water from the top, working down and allow to air dry.

Safety Posters [A4]

Sizes: A4 (210x297)

Materials: Rigid Plastic or Adhesive Sticker

Effective Hand Sanitising

- Apply a small amount (about 3ml) of the product in to soaped hands
- Rub hands together palm to palm, spreading the hand rub over the hands
- Rub back of each hand with palm of other hand with fingers interlocked
- Rub palm to palm with fingers interlocked
- Rub back of the fingers to opposite palm with fingers interlocked
- Rub each thumb clasped in opposite hand using a rotational movement
- Rub tips of fingers in opposite palm in a circular motion
- Rub each wrist with opposite hand
- Wet and product has evaporated and hands are dry (do not use paper towels)

Hand Washing Technique with Soap & Water

- Wet hands with water
- Apply enough soap to cover all hands surface
- Rub hands palm to palm
- Rub back of each hand with palm of other hand with fingers interlocked
- Rub palm to palm with fingers interlocked
- Rub with back of fingers to opposite palm with fingers interlocked
- Rub each thumb clasped in opposite hand using a rotational movement
- Rub tips of fingers in opposite palm in a circular motion
- Rub each wrist with opposite hand
- Rinse hands with water
- Use elbow to turn off tap
- Dry thoroughly with a single-use towel

The 10 Golden Rules
For the Control of Substances Hazardous to Health (COSHH)

- Always read the label and follow the instructions for use.
- Never use chemicals. **NEVER CHEMICALS CAN KILL!**
- Always use protective equipment provided.
- Never put chemicals into containers with other uses such as eating and drinking vessels.
- Always store chemicals safely. Store chemicals in a cool, dry and locked location.
- Never put chemicals into unlabelled containers!
- Know the first aid treatment required if you occasionally spill chemicals on yourself or others.
- Always report any faulty equipment, spillage or damaged containers to your supervisors.
- Develop safe working practice around the workplace and always follow the rules.
- If you find anything wrong report to your supervisor.

Colour Coding
For Cleaning Materials and Equipment

The aim of a Colour Coding system is to prevent cross contamination during the cleaning process

- Blue** General low risk areas
- Green** General catering & kitchen areas
- Yellow** Clinical / vehicle interiors
- Red** General washroom & toilet areas

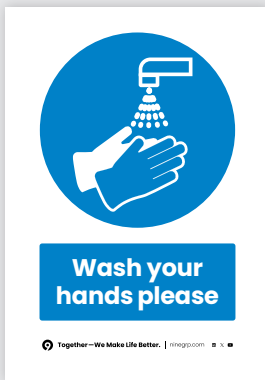
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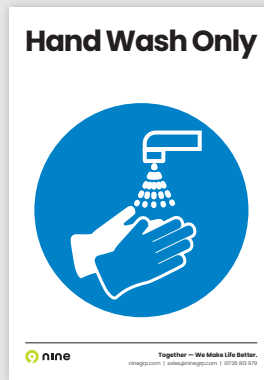
